Minutes

1. Preparing to Cilect Congress in Guadalajara, Mexico

The meeting accepted following documents to be sent to members. These will be on agenda on October 28 in Guadalajara.

There are currently 160 registered participants. The deadline has been extended and the final number is expected to be around 180.

The treasurer explained the budget situation and stated that by the end of 2026 the savings from Covid period have been spent. The coordinator's tasks could include applying for additional funding in the upcoming years.

Dignam briefed the board about the current situation of the SCEDI proposal, particularly about the feedback from legal council and from members.

5 applications have been received to the regional council elections: Patrick Geeraerts (RITCS, Belgium) for the position of vice chair or member, Lucy Brown (Westminster, UK), Jelena Modrić (ADU, Croatia), Jan Nåls (Arcada, Finland) and Julie Tingaud (La Fémis, France) for the position of member.

A preliminary program will be available on the third week of October. Coordinator has added the starting and ending times and hotel information to the web page. Thus far, 17 members have registered to the event.

3. Unesco update

Dignam participated in the Unesco celebration in Paris at the beginning of October.

FilmEU has published a position paper on the evolution of AI in the cultural and creative industries and its relation to European values, cultural diversity, educational excellence, and human-centred creativity. It will be included in the next Newsletter.
