Minutes

1. The minutes of the previous meeting were accepted. The agenda was accepted.

2. Update on invoicing

Rinne told about the invoicing situation. The membership fees of five schools are still unpaid (two in process) and the fees of schools in Russia as well as those who have left Cilect will be chased for the moment. It was agreed that Julie Tingaud will contact two French schools that haven't paid.

The meeting has a brief discussion the future revenues and financial situation.

3. Update on French prefecture

All the documents related to the update of the Board members and the new statutes were submitted on the Paris Prefecture's website on December 19. At this stage, the files are still under review and validation. No official receipts or confirmation has been received, therefore, contact with the bank is still pending.

GEECT needs to be registered to VAT system. Dignam has sent correspondence to Tingaud.

The deadline for conferences and meetings is end of January. Usually, the leadership symposium has been arranged in April. The decisions will be made at the meeting on February 20.

7. Clermont-Ferrand Short Film Festival & Market

Dignam will attend the festival (without cost to GEECT). In 2027 GEECT aims to organize a BIP together with interested schools.

Brown informed about the FEST, aimed at young filmmakers and taking place in Portugal in June.

Tingaud reminded that Munich film school festival is a good platform for networking.
